The tenth meeting of the GCISD Bond Steering Committee was held on April 5, 2005, in the Timberline Elementary Enrichment Center. The meeting began at 6:00 p.m.

All four subcommittees submitted their remaining recommendations. Sue Harry tabulated the vote results; they are recorded below. In total, the BSC voted 33 -1 for the bond package to be \$108,105,041.
